1. Call to Order – A quorum was present and the meeting was called to order at 10:05 by Commissioner Fritzsche. Commissioners Muehlbach, Wade, Waier and Wittman were present. Michael Wade, Technology and Communications chair, and Maggie Peplow, Assistant Treasurer were also present.

2. Welcome to Joe Muehlbach – New Commissioner

3. Approval of minutes from the meeting on May 2, 2022.

Minutes of the May 2, 2022, meeting minutes were distributed prior to the meeting. Motion to approve the minutes was made by Commissioner Waier and seconded by Commissioner Wittman. Minutes were unanimously approved.

4. Comments from members of the public who wish to address the Commission.

There were no members of the public present at this meeting.

5. Treasurer's Report.

Assistant Treasurer, Maggie Peplow presented the treasurer's report as of 06/30/2022. A motion was made by Commissioner Wittman to reallocate funds up to \$5K to conduct a whole lake survey. Commissioner Waier seconded the motion. Motion was unanimously approved. A motion to approve the treasurer's report was made by Commissioner Wade and seconded by Commissioner Fritzsche. Treasurer's report was unanimously approved.

6. Update on Lake Management actions including early season aquatic plant survey of the Twins.

Commissioner Wittman reported that the early season Point Intercept (PI) survey does not support a spot EWM treatment on South Twin. A survey will be conducted this fall by Onterra as well as an update to the Lake Management Plan.

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A motion was made by Commissioner Wittman to amend our AIS Small Scale Population Management grant, ACEI28622 for various cost items including increased DASH and PI survey costs as well as other changes considered necessary, and to extend the grant to 12/31/2023. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Waier. Motion was unanimously approved.

7. Planning for 2022 Annual Meeting:

- b. Discussion of the 2023 Lake Management actions –
 - Three weeks of DASH
 - Possible spot treatment
 - Onterra point intercept (PI) survey – both lakes

 - Buoy Replacement
- d. Draft Budget – presented for review.

8. Discussion on Muskellunge stocking.

Mr. Wade reported the Twins will be restocked with Musky fingerlings (12-14 inches) during September, 2022 at no cost to the District.

9. Discussion on lake buoy replacement.

We have had issues with buoys breaking away from their anchors as well as some buoys have been damaged, are leaking and need to be replaced. Quotes are being secured and we will budget for replacement of them for the 2023 season.
