*The North and South Twin Lakes District filed for and received a **\$7,047 Wisconsin DNR Clean Boats Clean Waters (CBCW) Grant**. This grant covers approximately **75% of the cost** of the Lake District's CBCW program for the 2023 boating season.*

*In 2023 the Lake District will be providing, with the aid of the DNR grant, **400 hours of monitoring**. CBCW representatives will be present at all **three of the public landings on North and South Twin at various times, primarily weekends**, throughout the summer boating season.*

*The primary objective for these monitors (college interns) is to **educate boaters on preventing the spread of aquatic invasive species (AIS) and check for all of types of invasive species: plant life; bait fish; and mollusks on boats, trailers and in live-wells**. This is an **informational campaign, not an enforcement activity**. The intent is to help prevent the introduction of aquatic invasive species in Wisconsin's surface waters or limit the spread of AIS that may already be present.*
